A further fee of \$20.00 per hour may be charged to the applicant for every hour, or part of an hour required for a CCTV Analyst employed in this office to undertake all actions necessary to enable a request to view CCTV data to be met (such as obtaining and cueing CCTV data) and, if applicable, to view CCTV data with the applicant and make and provide a copy of CCTV data at the request of the applicant. The applicant shall be given an estimate of any further costs for obtaining the desired CCTV data footage and the application will be processed only when the applicant agrees in writing to pay the total amount. In appropriate circumstances the initial application fee and/or the further hourly charge may be waived. Whether or not a fee or charge is waived is solely at the discretion of the Keeper of Evidence.
- 5. All CCTV data footage is the property of the Department of Economic Development, Jobs, Transport & Resources and is released to the applicant for the purpose stated within this application. The Keeper of Evidence permission is required if the applicant wishes to release the applied CCTV data footage to a third party not mentioned in the Public Transport CCTV Application.
- 6. In the case of any CCTV data that is the subject of an application by a media organisation, the Keeper of Evidence has deemed it necessary the media organisation MUST pixilate the images to protect the privacy of all persons depicted in the footage.
- 7. The Keeper of Evidence may also deem it necessary to apply condition 6 to any other CCTV footage that is the subject of a Public Transport Data Application.

**GROUNDS ON WHICH THE KEEPER OF EVIDENCE MIGHT REFUSE RELEASE OF CCTV DATA**Release of any information is subject to the discretion of the Keeper of Evidence and you will be advised if the information is not able to be released. The grounds on which the Keeper of Evidence might refuse to release CCTV footage are set out below.

The Keeper will ordinarily refuse to authorise release of CCTV footage where release could:

- 1. Damage the security or defence of the Commonwealth of Australia or of any State or Territory of the Commonwealth;
- 2. Prejudice the investigation of any crime or the fair trial of any person;
- 3. Disclose a confidential source of information;
- 4. Disclose methods of preventing, detecting or investigating any crime;

- 5. Endanger the life or physical safety of any person;
- 6. Involve unreasonable disclosure of information relating to the personal affairs of any person; or
- 7. Otherwise not be in the public interest.
